Terms and Conditions:

- Individual music tuition fees for 2024 will be R5 790 per annum charged at R579 per month over a period of 10 months.
- Music tuition in pairs will be R3 690 per annum charged at R369 per month for a period of 10 months. Subject to availability of a suitable 'partner'.
- Music tuition for 25 minute lessons will be R3 690 per annum charged at R369 per month for a period of 10 months. This option is only offered to those students taking music for the first time, as well as those who would like to take up a second instrument. Subject to approval by the music department.
- The above fee includes 32 lessons per annum. You will be charged for the number of lessons received, calculated at the end of the year. Should your child exceed the maximum number of lessons for whatever reason, you will be notified in advance of the options.
- If a student chooses to start music later in the year, the fee may be adjusted to take into account the estimated lessons remaining for the year. This will be communicated should it be different to the amounts stated above.
- A monthly fee of R116 will be charged for orchestra, ensembles and marimba groups should your child not be a music student at the school.
- It is advisable that your child does not take part in more than two music group activities due to practice times which sometimes overlap.
- Lesson periods will be 40 minutes, unless otherwise specified.
- Please be advised that a **calendar months' notice** must be submitted in writing to the Head of Music, when lessons are to be discontinued.
- Instruments are an essential component of music tuition and development. Kindly purchase the relevant instrument or contact the music department should you be interested in hiring an instrument for your child (this is subject to availability).
- If needed, students will be required to purchase their own music books. Examination fees are also charged for participation in external examinations.
- Teachers prepare students for concerts, eisteddfods, external examinations, (practical and theory), tests and competitions. This preparation is taken as part of the music tuition offered by the Music Department.
- Should your child be absent due to illness, normal tuition fees will be charged. Teachers will try to arrange an alternative time, but this is not guaranteed.
- Please return application forms by **Friday, 26 January 2024**.
